### Capacity

If demand for seats exceeds supply, priority will be given to scientists from desertification-affected developing countries, and then scientists globally involved in this topic.

The Scientific Conference will deliberate recommendations to be made to the COP through the UNCCD Committee on Science and Technology. All Scientific Conference sessions will be held in plenary, organized around three working group topics. Background white papers on these topics will be available at the UNCCD website after July 31, 2009.
